

# IID Storage and Organization

STEP BY STEP DIRECTIONS TO ORGANIZE YOUR DEVICE



## Keep Your Cord Tangle Free

An empty cardboard paper towel roll or wrapping paper roll can be used to create a sleeve for your cord. You will just cut a slit down one side of the roll and then it can easily slide over top of your device cord. You can secure the sleeve in place.

You can also use removable hooks to route your cord along the middle console of your vehicle. This will help to keep passengers, backpacks, or other materials that are in the passenger side of the vehicle from becoming tangled in the IID cord.



## Easy Dashboard Access

You will frequently need to provide a random retest (meaning you will blow into the device) while you're driving. You will always need to have your ignition interlock device ready. You can ensure that your device is conveniently located on your vehicle's dash by using removable velcro strips.

Choose a spot to mount your device that is within a hand's reach and that doesn't interfere with your ability to access your temperature or other controls. Mounting the breathalyzer portion of your device will ensure that you will always know where the device is and that is safe and secure. This will also help prevent the mouthpiece portion of your interlock device from accumulating dirt, dust and other debris that often accumulates in vehicle consoles or floorboards.

An alternative way to hang your device on the dashboard is to attach a large binder clip on the device. The device can then be hung from a removable adhesive hook on the dashboard.
