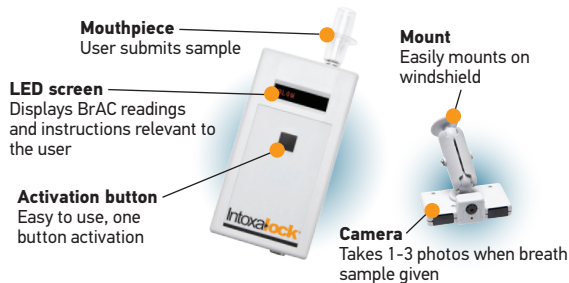
HOW CAN I GET MY LICENSE BACK?

If you are reading this brochure, it is likely that you or a loved one has been pulled over for Driving While Intoxicated (DWI). Getting an ignition interlock device installed in your vehicle is an important step in regaining your license in Minnesota. This brochure will take you through all the necessary steps based on your offense and will assist you in getting back on the road quickly and legally.*

WHAT IS AN IGNITION INTERLOCK?

An ignition interlock device (IID)* integrates breath alcohol testing with your vehicle's ignition system. Prior to starting your vehicle, you will need to submit a breath sample into the hand held portion of the device that tests for the presence of alcohol. If your Breath Alcohol Concentration (BrAC) is below Minnesota's ignition interlock set limit (0.02), your vehicle will start. If alcohol is detected, your vehicle will not start until a passing sample has been provided.



*A camera is also a Minnesota IID requirement.

FIRST OFFENSE

For a first offense DWI in Minnesota, your license will be revoked. However, you may still regain driving privileges with the installation of an IID.

Ignition interlock participants who have been revoked must complete the following steps:

- Pass the DWI knowledge test
- Pay the \$680 reinstatement fee (must submit receipt)
- Apply for a new Class D driver's license and pay application fee (must submit receipt)
- Sign and date the Ignition Interlock Participation Agreement, form PS31202
- Submit a Certificate of Insurance for the vehicles to be equipped with an ignition interlock, form PS31201
- Install an ignition interlock and provide application paperwork to Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS)

SECOND OFFENSE

For a second offense DWI in Minnesota within a ten year period, your license will be revoked for one to two years. However, you may still regain driving privileges with the installation of an IID.

Ignition interlock participants who have been revoked must complete the following steps:

- Pass the DWI knowledge test
- Pay the \$680 reinstatement fee (must submit receipt)
- Apply for a new Class D driver's license and pay application fee (must submit receipt)
- Sign and date the Ignition Interlock Participation Agreement, form PS31202
- Submit a Certificate of Insurance for the vehicles to be equipped with an ignition interlock, form PS31201
- If required, sign and notarize the Special Review Awareness Form, form PS31086
- Install an ignition interlock and provide application paperwork to DVS. Participants will receive their restricted license once DVS approves the application.

THIRD & SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES

For a third offense DWI in Minnesota within a ten year period, or if you have four or more alcohol offenses on record, your license will be canceled as “inimical to public safety.” However, you may still regain driving privileges with the installation of an IID.

Ignition interlock participants who have been canceled or denied must complete the following steps:

- Enroll in a treatment program as recommended by a chemical use evaluation. Treatment provider or assessor must submit enrollment documents directly to DVS
- Pass the DWI knowledge test
- Pay the \$680 reinstatement fee (must submit receipt)
- Apply for a new Class D driver’s license and pay application fee (must submit receipt)
- Sign and date the Ignition Interlock Participation Agreement, form PS31202
- Sign and date the Application for Ignition Interlock Limited License, from PS31203
- Submit a Certificate of Insurance for the vehicles to be equipped with an ignition interlock, form PS31201
- Sign and notarize a Last Use Statement, form PS31083
- Install an ignition interlock and provide application paperwork to DVS

In the case of third and subsequent offenses you must drive a vehicle with an IID and have no detection of alcohol or drugs for:

3rd Offense: Three years with an IID (one year limited license and two years restricted license)

4th Offense: Four years with an IID (one year limited license and three years restricted license)

5th Offense: Six years with an IID (one year limited license and five years restricted license)

- A limited license is a paper license that is issued while driving privileges are revoked allowing you to drive to work, school and abstinence-based support programs.
- A restricted license allows a person to only drive a vehicle equipped with an IID.



CALIBRATIONS

The state of Minnesota requires that all ignition interlock devices be calibrated every 60 days. A calibration consists of exchanging your current device for a newly calibrated one, ensuring accurate and consistent testing.

Intoxalock auto-calibrations

Intoxalock offers its customers auto-calibrations in the state of Minnesota. When your current device is due for calibration, the LED screen will display a message alerting you it is time to exchange devices. Intoxalock will automatically send a new one to your selected service center. You simply need to visit your service center during the allotted calibration period and a technician will quickly exchange the device.
