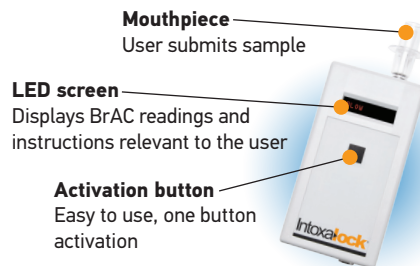
## HOW CAN I GET MY LICENSE BACK?

If you are reading this brochure, it is likely that you or a loved one has been pulled over for Driving while Under the Influence of Intoxicants (DUII). Getting an ignition interlock device installed in your vehicle is an important step in regaining your license in Oregon. This brochure will take you through all the necessary steps based on your offense and will assist you in getting back on the road quickly and legally.\*

## WHAT IS AN IGNITION INTERLOCK?

An ignition interlock device integrates breath alcohol testing with your vehicle's ignition system. Prior to starting your vehicle, you will need to submit a breath sample into the hand held portion of the device that tests for the presence of alcohol. If your BrAC (Breath Alcohol Concentration) is below Oregon's ignition interlock limit (0.02), your vehicle will start. If alcohol is detected, your vehicle will not start until a passing sample has been provided.

## FIRST CONVICTION

If you were convicted of a first offense DUII in Oregon, your license will be suspended for one year. However, you may still regain driving privileges with the installation of an ignition interlock device.

### To obtain your Hardship Permit, you must:

- Sign and date a Hardship Permit application, Department of Motor Vehicle form 735-6044
- Pay a \$50 non-refundable application fee
- Submit a \$75 reinstatement fee
- Obtain a recommendation from the convicting judge\*
- Submit a SR-22 Certificate of Liability Insurance
- Install an ignition interlock device for the length of your Hardship Permit

\*Not required under Implied Consent

## SECOND CONVICTION

If you were convicted of a second offense DUII in Oregon, your license will be suspended for three years. However, you may still regain driving privileges with the installation of an ignition interlock device.

### To obtain your Hardship Permit, you must:

- Wait 90 days of your suspension
- Sign and date a Hardship Permit application, Department of Motor Vehicle form 735-6044
- Pay a \$50 non-refundable application fee
- Submit a \$75 reinstatement fee
- Obtain a recommendation from the convicting judge\*
- Submit a SR-22 Certificate of Liability Insurance
- Obtain a mental health recommendation from an approved treatment provider
- Install an ignition interlock device for the length of your Hardship Permit

### THIRD & SUBSEQUENT CONVICTIONS

If you were convicted of a third or subsequent DUI offense in Oregon, your license will be subject to permanent revocation. However, you may still regain driving privileges with the installation of an ignition interlock device.

#### To obtain your Hardship Permit, you must:

- Wait one year of your suspension
- Sign and date a Hardship Permit application, Department of Motor Vehicle form 735-6044
- Pay a \$50 non-refundable application fee
- Submit a \$75 reinstatement fee
- Obtain a recommendation from the convicting judge\*
- Submit a SR-22 Certificate of Liability Insurance
- Obtain a mental health recommendation from an approved treatment provider
- Install an ignition interlock device for the length of your Hardship Permit

\*Not required under Implied Consent

### IMPLIED CONSENT

**Suspension lengths may be increased if any of the following occurred within five years prior to your arrest:**

- DUI conviction in Oregon or any other jurisdiction
- Participation in a diversion or similar alcohol or drug program in Oregon or any other jurisdiction
- Suspension of driving privileges under the Oregon Implied Consent Law

Under Implied Consent, your suspension may be subject to longer suspension periods based on the reason for your suspension. For more details, visit [www.oregon.gov](http://www.oregon.gov)

#### To obtain your Hardship Permit under Implied Consent, you must:

- Sign and date a Hardship Permit application, Department of Motor Vehicle form 735-6044
- Pay a \$50 non-refundable application fee
- Submit a \$75 reinstatement fee
- Submit a SR-22 Certificate of Liability Insurance
- Obtain employment verification in the form of a signed letter from your employer stating your work days, hours and needs for on-the-job driving, if applicable



### CALIBRATIONS

The state of Oregon requires that all ignition interlock devices be calibrated every 60 days. A calibration consists of exchanging your current device for a newly calibrated one, ensuring accurate and consistent testing.

#### Intoxalock direct exchange calibrations

Intoxalock offers its customers direct exchange calibrations in the state of Oregon. When it is time for calibration, the LED screen will display a message alerting you it is time to exchange devices. Intoxalock will automatically send a new one to your home address. You simply swap out your current device with the newly calibrated one and ship back the old one with the provided return label. Intoxalock's direct exchange program saves you time and money by eliminating the need to return to a service center for the calibration process.
