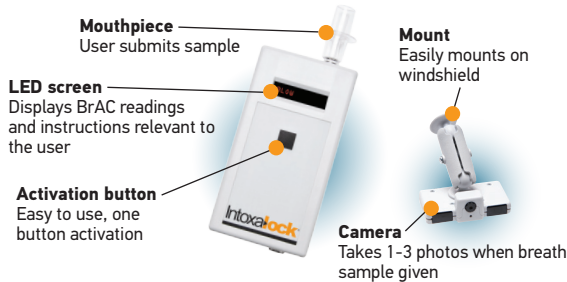
## HOW CAN I GET MY LICENSE BACK?

If you are reading this brochure, it is likely that you or a loved one has been pulled over for Driving Under the Influence (DUI). Getting an ignition interlock device installed in your vehicle is an important step in regaining your license in Pennsylvania. This brochure will take you through all the necessary steps based on your offense and will assist you in getting back on the road quickly and legally.\*

## WHAT IS AN IGNITION INTERLOCK?

An ignition interlock device (IID)\* integrates breath alcohol testing with your vehicle's ignition system. Prior to starting your vehicle, you will need to submit a breath sample into the hand held portion of the device that tests for the presence of alcohol. If your Breath Alcohol Concentration (BrAC) is below the state's set limit (0.020), your vehicle will start. If alcohol is detected, your vehicle will not start until a passing sample has been provided.



\*A camera is also a Tennessee IID requirement.

## FIRST OFFENSE

If you are convicted of a first offense DUI in Tennessee, your license will be suspended for one year. You may be required to install an Ignition Interlock Device (IID) in your vehicle.

**To regain your license, you must first complete the following:**

- Serve appropriate jail time
- Pay fines ranging from \$350 to \$1,500
- One year license revocation
- Participate in an alcohol and drug treatment program
- Pay restitution to any person suffering physical injury or personal loss

## SECOND OFFENSE

If you are convicted of a second offense DUI in Tennessee, your license will be suspended for two years. You may be ordered to install an IID in your vehicle.

**To regain your license, you must first complete the following:**

- Serve appropriate jail time
- Pay fines ranging from \$600 to \$3,500
- Two years license revocation\*
- Participate in an alcohol and drug treatment program
- Pay restitution to any person suffering physical injury or personal loss
- If convicted of two DUI offenses in five years, an IID will be required for six months at your expense

\*A Restricted License is available after the first year of revocation

## THIRD OFFENSE

If you are convicted of a third offense DUI in Tennessee, your license will be suspended for up to ten years. You may be ordered to install an IID in your vehicle.

**To regain your license, you must first complete the following:**

- Serve appropriate jail time
- Pay fines ranging from \$1,100 to \$10,000
- Six to ten years license revocation\*
- Participate in an alcohol and drug treatment program
- If convicted of two DUI offenses in five years, an IID will be required for six months at your expense

## FOURTH & SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES

If you are convicted of a fourth or subsequent offense DUI in Tennessee, your license will be suspended for eight years. You may be ordered to install an IID in your vehicle.

**To regain your license, you must first complete the following:**

- Serve appropriate jail time
- Pay a fine ranging from \$3,000 to \$15,000
- Eight years license revocation\*
- Participate in an alcohol and drug treatment program
- If convicted of two DUI offenses in five years, an IID will be required for six months at your own expense

\*A Restricted License is not available

## LICENSE REINSTATEMENT FEES

- \$100 reinstatement fee
- \$50 proof of financial responsibility (SR22) filing fee, if required
- \$75 fee for failure to surrender driver license, if required
- \$3 certification fee if the violation occurred in Tennessee
- Required to apply for a valid license and pay appropriate fees

## CALIBRATIONS

The state of Tennessee requires that all ignition interlock devices be calibrated every 30 days. A calibration consists of exchanging your current device for a newly calibrated one, ensuring accurate and consistent testing.

### Intoxalock auto-calibrations

Intoxalock offers its customers auto-calibrations in the state of Tennessee. When your current device is due for calibration, the LED screen will display a message alerting you it is time to exchange devices. Intoxalock will automatically send a new one to your selected service center. You simply need to visit your service center during the allotted calibration period and a technician will quickly exchange the device.
