

## **Steps for IID Removal**

## Follow the steps below for removal of an Ignition Interlock Device (IID):

Step 1	<b>Contact your Ignition Interlock Vendor to initiate a Removal Hearing and</b> request a copy of your device record to review. Within a 24 hour period the Massachusetts (RMV) Ignition Interlock Department will get in touch to conduct that hearing telephonically.
Step 2	On this phone hearing, the RMV will review the data to determine if any <b>lockouts</b> or <b>violations</b> have occurred in the past <b>six (6) months</b> .
Step 3	If you have any <b>lockouts</b> or <b>violations</b> , your IID removal request will be denied. You will be required to participate in the IID program for an <b>additional six (6)</b> <b>months</b> from the date of your last <b>lockout and/or violation</b> .
Step 4	If you do not have any <b>lockouts</b> or <b>violations</b> , the RMV's Ignition Interlock Department will approve the IID removal. The Hearings Officer will remove your Interlock license restriction (T).
Step 5	It is necessary that you obtain a duplicate unrestricted license. Visit the RMV Website at <u>https://www.mass.gov/how-to/replace-your-drivers-</u> <u>license</u> for more information or call the customer contact center at 857-368- 8000 for assistance.
Step 6	At your discretion, return to your IID vendor/service provider to have the IID removed. This is not a Program Requirement.
